DR. GIARRIZZO and OLIVIA BUATSI- BUDGET DISCUSSION

- Thank you to the SCA for their hard work and volunteerism.
- North Shore was one of only 6 districts in Nassau County to open full time for K-8 this year during the pandemic.
- We need to make sure we have the resources to bridge the educational losses from this past year.
- Class size will be pretty stable at GWL this year.

- If you know incoming Kindergartens, please encourage them to register.
- American Sign Language and Dance electives added and now expanding in high school.
- Instrument improvements
- Special Education ILC program moving to high school level.
- Technology Enhancements
- Proposition 1 Budget Increase of 1.2%
- Capital Reserves GWL air conditioning was funded through the capital reserves.
- It is essentially a savings account for long term projects.
- Bond from 2019 GWL will get security vestibule.
- Proposition 2 sets up reserves (savings) to improve athletic fields and programs in 5-6 years.
- It is untrue that the district has \$34 million in reserves that can be used for athletics now.
